## MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE APEX COUNCIL OF CRICKET ASSOCIATION OF UTTARAKHAND HELD ON TUESDAY, 13<sup>TH</sup> JANUARY, 2026.

Hon. President welcomed all the members of the Apex Council and confirmed from Hon. Secretary that the required quorum was completed called the meeting in order and requested the Hon. Secretary to commence the meeting as per agenda.

Hon. Secretary welcomed all the members of the Apex Council and started the meeting.

**Agenda No. 1: To confirm the minutes of previous Apex Council Meeting dated 15.12.2025.**

The Hon. Secretary informed the house that draft minutes of previous Apex Council Meeting had been circulated to all the members and requested to confirm the minutes.

**“RESOLVED THAT,** *the Apex Council unanimously resolved to confirm the Minutes of the previous Apex Council Meeting dated 15.12.2025 as circulated.*

**Agenda No. 2: To discuss about the Upcoming Cricketing Activities of CAU.**

The CEO informed the House that the U-14 Central Zone Raj Singh Dungarpur Trophy has been scheduled to commence from **15 January 2026**. He further apprised that the CAU U-14 team will play four league matches against Madhya Pradesh Cricket Association (MPCA), Uttar Pradesh Cricket Association (UPCA), Vidarbha Cricket Association (VCA), and Rajasthan Cricket Association (RCA).

The CEO further informed the House that the **U-15 Women’s team** has delivered a commendable performance in the ongoing tournament and has successfully qualified for the Pre-Quarter Final stage, reflecting the positive progress of women’s cricket within the Association.

He also apprised the House that CAU has scheduled **training and selection camps** for the following categories:

**Senior Men (Open Category)**

**Senior Men (Under-23 Category)**

**Senior Women’s Team**

**“RESOLVED THAT,** The Apex Council took note of the above information and appreciated the efforts of the teams and support staff.

**Agenda No.3: To discuss about the Payment Notice of Tanush Cricket Academy.**

The CEO informed the House that Tanush Cricket Academy has served a notice upon the Cricket Association of Uttarakhand (CAU) demanding payment of Rs 67,97,261.00

The Treasurer apprised the House that CAU has received a GST reversal amounting to **Rs 14,62,116.00** and that TDS of Rs. 3,27,258.00 has already been deducted from older invoices of Tanush Cricket Academy. The Treasurer further stated that the above amounts are required to be adjusted and deducted from the total amount being demanded by Tanush Cricket Academy. It was further informed that CAU has not received any work order, invoice, or supporting documents for the amounts of Rs. 16,65393.00 and Rs. 18,72,979.00.

The Treasurer placed on record that the previous Apex Council had approved payment of the UPL invoice amounting to Rs. 16,65393.00, and therefore, it was proposed that the said amount may be released accordingly.

However, with regard to the amount of Rs. 1872979.00 it was proposed that no payment shall be made until proper invoice, work order, or written approval/email is submitted by Tanush Cricket Academy.

It was further proposed that the balance admissible payment, after all necessary adjustments, may be released in two to three installments, subject to the availability of funds.

**“RESOLVED THAT, the Apex Council unanimously accepted the proposal of the Hon. Treasurer and authorized treasurer to inform accordingly to Tanush Cricket Academy.”**

**Agenda No. 4: Any other matter with the permission of Hon. President.**

1. The CEO informed the House that the tenure of the ICA nominee, Mr. Shantanu Sugewar, has been completed. The House was further informed that Mr. Vishal Singh Yadav has been nominated by the ICA as its nominee in his place.

**“RESOLVED THAT, the Apex Council unanimously accepted the Mr. Vishal Singh Yadav as ICA nominee.**

2. The Secretary informed the House that Ms. Aradhya Bisht, a player from the U-15 Women’s team, had caused a disturbance within the team due to certain issues. The Secretary further stated that a complaint in this regard had been received via email from the team physiotherapist, bringing the matter to official notice.

**“RESOLVED THAT, After due discussion, the Apex Council decided that Ms. Aradhya Bisht should be issued a strict warning for her conduct”.**

3. The Secretary informed the House that an application had been received from Mr. Gurveer Mann Singh, expressing his interest in being engaged as a consultant for the purpose of fund collection for the Association.

**“RESOLVED THAT, the Apex Council unanimously accepted the application of Mr. Gurveer Mann Singh and granted permission for his engagement as a Consultant”.**

4. The Secretary informed the House that the Association had received several complaints pertaining to the Haridwar District. Consequent upon these complaints, the President of the Haridwar District submitted his resignation to the Association. Taking cognizance of the matter, the Secretary proposed that a committee be constituted by the Association to oversee and supervise the cricketing activities and also to submit a report to the CAU of the status of

Haridwar District with respect to administrative, governance and compliance of the District Association.

**“RESOLVED THAT,** *the Apex Council unanimously accepted the proposal of the Hon. Secretary and resolved to constitute a committee to look after and supervise the cricketing activities of the Haridwar District and also to submit a report to the CAU of the status of Haridwar District with respect to administrative, governance and compliance of the District Association”.*

**The Committee shall comprise the following members:**

1. Mr. Ajay Pandey, Vice President, CAU
2. Mr. Arun Negi, Member, CAU
3. Mr. Amit Roy, Member, CAU

5. The Secretary placed before the Apex Council a proposal stating that, as the employees of the Operations Department are required to work additional hours during the playing season, they should be granted an annual remuneration as a measure to acknowledge their efforts and to boost morale.

**RESOLVED THAT,** *the Apex Council unanimously accepted the proposal of the Hon. Secretary and fixed an amount of Rs. 20,000/- each as annual remuneration for Mr. Ajay Bisht, Mr. Rajdeep, Mr. Parul, and Mr. Vikas”.*

6. The CEO informed the House that, pursuant to the decision taken in the previous Apex Council meeting, an audit of the Dehradun District had been requested. The Dehradun District was duly informed of the same via email; however, no response has been received from the Dehradun District to date.

**RESOLVED THAT,** *the Apex Council directed the CEO to send a reminder email to the Dehradun District Cricket Association”.*

**There being no other item on agenda to be discussed, the meeting concluded with a vote of thanks to the chair.**
